## REGIONAL CONFERENCES

You are invited to the Governor's Faith-Based Organization Disaster Initiative Regional Conferences to be held across Missouri. All conferences run from 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and lunch will be served. The goal of the Initiative is to support Missouri's faith community in preparing for disasters and to facilitate the use of time, talent and treasure in assisting those in need. On August 26, Gov. Jay Nixon addressed almost 300 faith leaders in Jefferson City to "kickoff" Phase II of the Initiative. The regional conferences will offer hands-on preparedness training and are designed to link faith organizations directly with area emergency management directors and responders. We hope to see you there for what we believe is an invaluable opportunity to prepare to respond together.

Phase II attempts to expand the Faith-based Organization Disaster Initiative by identifying and reaching out to more faith groups across Missouri and by directly extending invitations to local organizations as well as the leadership of their denominations. The goal of Phase II is to encourage greater collaboration between faith-based organizations and local emergency managers and to provide tool kits, mentoring sources, technical assistance, and training resources to build lasting relationships between emergency management directors, other faith groups, and all those working to assist their communities.
