- Class Title:** AWR 136 Essentials of Community Cyber Security (DHS Approved) (POST Approved)
- Class Date:** April 12, 2017 (8:00 am-12:00 pm)

- Course Description:** This course provides individuals, community leaders and first-responders with information on how cyber-attacks can impact, prevent, and/or stop operations and emergency responses in a community. It also serves as a cursory introduction to cyber threats, vulnerabilities, and countermeasures. It explains vulnerabilities of computer systems and networks and how these vulnerabilities can affect communities. The course introduces actions communities can take in establishing a cyber security program. **NOTE:** Immediately after completion of the AWR136 the MGT385 Community Cyber Security Exercise Planning course will be delivered. The MGT385 will be held on April 12 from 1:00 pm-5:00 pm and continue on April 13 from 8:00 am-5:00 pm. *NOTE: Individuals who do not attend both the AWR136 and the MGT385 are not eligible for travel reimbursement.*
- Target Audience:** Personnel with no more than a basic understanding of cyber security that are involved with critical infrastructure, emergency operations, and incident response in public or private organizations, including state, county, and municipal officers; members of industry affiliations and chambers of commerce should attend.
- NOTE:** Private industry/sector personnel are invited to attend at no cost; however any travel expenses are the responsibility of the individual.
