- Class Title:** All-Hazards Planning Section Chief (PSC) Course (POST Approved)
- Class Date:** August 9-12, 2016
- Sponsor(s):** Missouri State Emergency Management Agency, University of Missouri Fire and Rescue Training Institute (MU FRTI), Missouri Incident Support Teams, Springfield/Greene County Office of Emergency Management
- Course Description:** This course is designed to provide local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective PSC on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories: PSC duties 1) managing the planning cycle, and 2) tracking resources and incident status. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable students to process and apply their new knowledge. Selection criteria: NIMS ICS Position Specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to functional, support, or unit leader positions on U.S. Fire Administration (USFA) or other Type III All-Hazards Incident Management Teams (AHIMT), or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions.
- Prerequisites:** Required: IS100, IS200, IS700, IS800, ICS300 and ICS400
- Target Audience:** NIMS ICS Position Specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to a Missouri Incident Support Team (IST) or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions.
