- Class Title:** AWR 232 Mass Fatalities Planning and Response for Rural Communities (DHS Approved) (POST Approved)
- Class Date:** June 8, 2017

- Course Description:** This 8-hour awareness-level, instructor-led course is designed to prepare rural first responders and officials with the basic knowledge, skills and abilities to manage a mass fatality incident impacting their jurisdiction. Issues addressed include establishing roles and responsibilities, assets management, remains processing and identification, diversity issues and development of a mass fatality plan that affect the construct of a mass fatality response. Prerequisites: It is recommended that attendees complete the following online courses prior to attending this class: IS100 – Introduction to the Incident Command System (ICS); IS700 – National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction; IS800 – National Response Framework (NRF), An Introduction.
