- Class Title:** AWR 232 Mass Fatalities Planning and Response for Rural Communities (DHS Approved) (POST Approved)

Issues addressed include establishing roles and responsibilities, assets management, remains processing and identification, diversity issues and development of a mass fatality plan that affect the construct of a mass fatality response. Prerequisites: It is recommended that attendees complete the following online courses prior to attending this class: IS100 – Introduction to the Incident Command System (ICS); IS700 – National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction; IS800 – National Response Framework (NRF), An Introduction.
