- Course Description:** The purpose of this course is to provide small, rural, and remote communities with the knowledge, skills, and abilities to effectively plan for and respond to events that require isolation and/or quarantine of their populations in a variety of low- and high-impact situations. Though certain aspects of isolation and quarantine are federally regulated, standard operating procedures, authorities, strategies, and statutes relating to isolation and quarantine vary from state to state. Without uniform standards across the response community, it is likely many response agencies have unclear understandings regarding how and when to implement, manage, and demobilize isolation and quarantine measures.
