**Class Title:**           **Damage Assessment**  
                                  **(POST Certified)**

**Class Date:**           **September 23, 2009**

**Course Description:**   **This course is designed to provide the student with a fundamental knowledge of the concepts and procedures used to conduct damage assessments following a natural or technological disaster. The course focuses on the collection of information needed by local, state and federal entities to determine the extent of damages, analysis of damages, identifying the resources needed to respond, and identification of assistance required by other agencies (State and Federal). The course is approximately four (4) hours in length and can be tailored to the needs of the local jurisdiction/organization. **NOTE: This is a 4 hour course, therefore meals and hotels will not be reimbursed.****
