Course Description: The Law Enforcement Active Shooter Emergency Response (LASER) course uses a mixture of classroom presentations, hands-on field training, and practical exercises to enhance the response capabilities of law enforcement officers in order to effectively respond to and stop an active shooter incident. This class aims to provide participants with the knowledge, skills, and abilities to rapidly deploy and neutralize violent offenders during active shooter incidents in order to prevent the loss of innocent lives. In addition, this course aims to teach and instruct others to do the same. The Train-the-Trainer iteration of the LASER course allows participants to become certified course instructors and deliver the course to their co-workers and their organization's employees

Prerequisites: All participants must be local or state law enforcement officers.
