**Class Title:** AWR156 Principles of Planning and Implementing Recovery (DHS Approved)  
(POST Approved)

**Class Date:** May 11, 2016

**Sponsor(s):** Missouri State Emergency Management Agency, Cass County OEM, Cass County Sheriff's Dept, the Rural Domestic Preparedness Consortium (RDPC)

**Course Description:** Using the lessons learned from the preceding courses in the curriculum, it trains traditional emergency responders and members of the agriculture community on recovery operations, procedures, and techniques following an incident of agroterrorism or food systems disaster. This course provides the fundamental framework for orchestrating the recovery from an incident of agroterrorism or food systems disaster. It defines recovery, and identifies the community stakeholders who must participate in the recovery and the activities involved in restoring public confidence and a sense of normalcy. This course provides specific steps for planning for recovery, both within participants' own organizations and as stakeholders in the larger community-wide incident command system. This course also helps enable participants to complete the overall curriculum and become members of frontline emergency response teams.
