- Class Title:** MGT417 Crisis Management for School-Based Incidents for Key Decision Makers (DHS Approved) (POST Certified)

- Course Description:** Utilizing an all-hazards approach, this two-day course will provide content instruction, develop concept-specific skills, and provide opportunities for law enforcement, school personnel, and community stakeholders to collaboratively apply the course objectives in scenario-based applications. Rural schools, law enforcement, other emergency responders, and community stakeholders are often limited in their access to resources, so it is imperative that all potentially affected parties collaborate in planning, preparation, communication, response, and recovery in the event of a school-based incident. Moreover, these affected parties must come together to practice their interoperable skills through drills and exercises to ensure the strategies in place provide for an effective crisis response and collaborative recovery.
- Prerequisites:** It is highly recommended that participants complete AWR148 Crisis Management for School-Based Incidents – Partnering Rural Law Enforcement, First Responders, and Local School Systems class or the online AWR148-W Crisis Management for School-Based Incidents – Partnering Rural Law Enforcement, First Responders, and Local School Systems – Web-based course.
